

Samson Stone & Iron Age Fort

Take a walk up to see Samson's Stone- a glacial erratic perched on the top of the hill with great views over Callander and Loch Venachar.

Description:

Length: 1 mile

Start: FCS Bochastle car park

Terrain: Hilly over uneven terrain

Route

Follow the blue waymarker arrows from the Bochastle car park into the Woodland Trust Estate.



From the car park follow the path onto the Woodland Trust Estate and then after a short distance turn right at the waymarker to start walking up the hill towards samsons stone. Descend down by passing by Samson's stone, through a gate and over a bridge before returning to the original track. Turn left at the path junction to return back to the Bochastle car park.

Continue on to the Iron Age Fort

To extend the walk, on returning to the path, turn right and continue along The Great Trossachs Path for a few hundred metres. After the junction (take the direction towards Brig o' Turk), a waymarker points to the path to the top of Dunmore Fort- an historic iron age fort.
