



## **Bochastle Walk, Callander**

Distance 4.75 miles

This walk begins from the Bochastle forestry car park.

Head west out of Callander on the A84

Turn left onto the A821

Once you see the Lade Inn you will see a sign for Bochastle car park. Turn right and park here.

From the car park follow the angled road that climbs steeply at first to join a forestry track. Soon the views will appear down the glen and ahead to [Ben Ledi](#),

The path starts to level out and you can see ahead to Loch Lubnaig in the distance.

As you approach the path which leads to Ben Ledi turn right.

The route will take you down through the trees. The path is quite steep in places. You can continue now on the cycle path as the trail can become very boggy. You can detour down to see the Falls of Leny.

Continue on until you reach the road then turn right and follow the path at the side of the road to return to the car park



Note:

You can extend this walk by a couple of miles by starting the walk from Callander.

From Callander Meadows follow cycle route 7 on a clear path until you reach a road.

Cross the road then turn left to reach the car park and the start of the walk.
