



Glencoe

A journey through one of Scotland's most dramatic landscapes.

- ❑ Take the A84 north west out of Callander
- ❑ Continue on the A84, passing the tranquil Loch Lubnaig on your left and on through the village of Strathyre.
- ❑ Continue on to Lochearnhead, the A84 now becomes the A85, follow signs for Crianlarich.
- ❑ Continue on the A85 to Crianlarich, it will take approximately 1 hour to reach Crianlarich from Callander.
- ❑ Drive through Crianlarich, continue straight ahead on the main road.
- ❑ The road now becomes the A82, follow it to Tyndrum.
- ❑ Just as you leave Tyndrum the road bends to the right - sign posted A82 Fort William.
- ❑ The scenery begins to change as the road climbs higher to Bridge of Orchy. If you are ready for coffee or lunch the Bridge of Orchy Hotel is excellent.
- ❑ Continue on the A82 through spectacular scenery to Ballachulish.
- ❑ You can end your journey here or continue on the A82 to Fort William and take a trip on the Nevis Range Mountain Gondola (closed mid November-mid December).
- ❑ Return to Callander by the same route, the views will be quite different on your return journey and equally stunning.
