

Callander to Strathyre Walk (Part of the Rob Roy Way)

Distance approx. 9 miles

This is a level walk on firm ground but the walk is fairly long so please ensure you have suitable footwear on as well as food and drink and some waterproofs.

The route can be completed in both directions but the views are best if you follow the Callander to Strathyre route.

From Callander Meadows Park join the C7 Cycle path. This is the route of the former Callander to Oban railway line which closed in 1965.

The first section of the path takes you over a bridge over the river before a gentle stroll along a clear path beside some fields.

As you walk along you will see Ben Ledi in front of you. You will pass some mounds in a field to the right, these are the remains of a Roman Fort

Keep walking until you reach a road, cross the road carefully then continue on the cycle path.

You will pass the Falls of Leny and you can detour down to see them before continuing on the clear path in the shadow of Ben Ledi

The final section of the path takes you past Loch Lubnaig, with views across to Stuc a'Chroin and Ben Vorlich before reaching Strathyre

From Strathyre you can return to Callander by bus C60 but please plan ahead as bus times are limited.

This walk is part of the Rob Roy Way, which begins in Drymen and ends at Pitlochry.
